

Draft Procedures :

OCASA Board of Directors reserves the right to make changes to any of the following procedures for the good of the league however will not change any procedures within 2 weeks prior to a draft day.

- 1: **Manager ONLY in draft**, there are **no protected coaches** if you want a coach - then you must draft his or her daughter.
2. The draft order will be in order of drawing numbers prior to draft.
3. Before the draft starts the OCASA Draft Representative will announce how many spots are open for players that wish to move up a division. These players are eligible to be drafted from the 1st grouping and on. Once the allotted spots are taken, no more under aged players will be drafted.
4. The draft order will run serpentine until all players are placed.
5. The draft will be a "Drop-out Draft". Each team will start picking in the first grouping and will drop out of the draft when their team is full.
6. There will be no discussion by managers regarding a player's playing ability during the draft or the possibility of trading the player.
7. Each team will have one minute to make a selection after having team name called.
8. Managers Daughter is protected, but will still fall into drafting procedure.
 - a. The Sibling, **aka Managers Daughter**, MUST be drafted in their draft grouping.
 - b. Any additional siblings, **aka Managers additional daughters**, MUST be drafted in their draft grouping until all siblings are drafted.
9. **There will be only one (1) trade allowed for an "alike" player, per Manager/Team, if a Manager/Team has already had a trade you may not trade with him/her.**
 - a: The player of trade must rank either one (1) higher or lower too other player of trade consideration.**
 - b: The trade will only be allowed for Draft night only of your division and you will have a time limit set by Player Agent, Division Coordinator, and/or Draft Director.**
10. If a team drafts a sibling, (**aka, SISTER ACT**), they **MUST** draft the other siblings in their groupings. Any and all other additional siblings in groupings must be drafted next until all siblings are drafted.

(Definition of Sibling: Is a sister or step sister only, who resides and can be verified living under the same residence as the other will be considered as a sibling. NO special circumstances will be allowed.)
11. Managers needing to fill out their rosters will then pull players who failed to attend evaluation day, this will be conducted as a blind draw after all players in all groupings have been assigned.

12. Player AGENT, Division Coordinator, and/or Draft Director will have the right to correct any obvious mistakes in the assignment of players to teams.
13. Upon completion of the draft, managers need to contact all players on their rosters within 48 hours. A team meeting should be held within 72 hours after the draft.
14. A Draft will not be conducted for the 6U division. The teams in this division will be formed by the The 6U Division Coordinator, Player Agent, and approved by the President of OCASA.
15. Wait List players will be added to teams who have less than a full team, by the Division Coordinator, however the Player Agent MUST approve a player whom is to be considered an A/B Pitcher or A/B Catcher.

Draft Procedures for Fall Ball

1. A draft will not be conducted for Fall Ball. The teams will be formed by the Board of Directors.
2. Managers will be able to protect 6 players for Fall Ball one being the Manager's daughter and any siblings of the manager are consider part of the 6 as well.
3. Each team will have a minimum of 10 players and a maximum of 12 players. High school, 8U, and 6U divisions will have a minimum of 10 players and a maximum of 13 players.
4. The OCASA Board of Directors reserves the right to add or remove any player from a team to balance pitching or team strength.
